Gudrun grew up in Saxony-Anhalt, studied medicine at the Martin-Luther-University **Halle-Wittenberg** where she passed her specialist exam in **radiology** before she migrated to Australia in **2005**. That year, Gudrun undertook a Research Fellowship in breast MRI at the University of Western Australia. In 2013, she was admitted a Fellow of The Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Radiologists. Dr Gudrun Peters is a trained radiologist at I-MED Radiology since 2010 and currently works in Tasmania for Australia's largest Imaging provider, I-MED Radiology Network.

Among her achievements in the breast imaging field, in 2008 Gudrun was Convenor and Presenter at the first Australian Inaugural Practice Breast MRI Course held in Perth. Gudrun was also invited to speak at the RANZCR Annual Scientific Meeting in 2010 and at the BreastScreen conference in 2011. She is author and co-author of more than 10 scientific publications in the field of breast imaging.
